



# Summer Camp Scholarship Application

The Summer Camp Scholarship Program was created to give local youth organizations the opportunity to enhance their programming through enrollment in a summer camp at The Durham Museum. It was expanded for the Summer of 2020 to incorporate opportunities for individual families. Thanks to the support of generous donors, the museum is able to offer low-cost camp enrollment to families meeting certain financial criteria, subject to availability. Applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Applicants must be residents of Douglas, Sarpy, Cass, or Washington counties in Nebraska, or Mills or Pottawattamie counties in Iowa.
2. The parent/guardian(s) listed on the application and their dependent children must reside in the same household.
3. Applicants must meet the Eligibility Guidelines for free meals as defined by the U.S. Health and Human Services department or receive SNAP or WIC benefits.

### How to Apply

1. Fill out the application form below. If you are applying for more than two children going into grades 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>, please feel free to continue onto the back of the form.
2. Assemble your application along with a \$5.00 application fee and one of the following documents:
  - a. A copy of letter on child’s school letterhead certifying that he/she/they are enrolled in the free lunch program, **or**
  - b. A copy of the approval letter stating applicant is enrolled in either SNAP or WIC program (copy of card will not be accepted)

If your scholarship is approved and funding is available, you will be notified by phone or e-mail; at that time we will proceed with your registration details including choice of camps. Camp scholarships are valid only for the summer immediately following approval and can be applied to:

- One full-day, week-long camp
- Two half-day, week-long camps (occurring within the same week)
